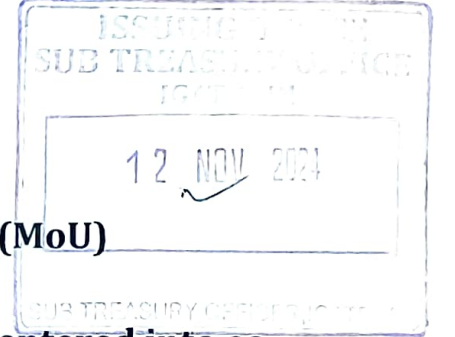

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into as

WHEREAS:

- The Supplier is engaged in the business of collecting, recycling, and supplying electronic waste (E-Waste) materials;
- The Recipient is engaged in [mention the recipient's business/sector, e.g., electronics recycling, refurbishment, manufacturing components, etc.];
- The parties wish to enter into a mutually beneficial relationship regarding the supply of E-Waste materials for [specify purpose].

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Purpose of the MoU

This MoU outlines the terms and conditions under which the Supplier will provide E-Waste materials to the Recipient for the purposes of [e.g., recycling, refurbishment, resale, or another stated purpose].

2. Scope of E-Waste Material Supply

The Supplier agrees to supply the following types of E-Waste materials to the Recipient:

- [List of materials: circuit boards, cables, batteries, monitors, etc.]
- CPU's
- Keyboards
- Monitors
- Printers
- Others electronics devices etc.

3. Supply Terms

The Supplier will deliver E-Waste materials as per the agreed-upon quantities. The expected supply schedule will be as per availability, with adjustments based on the Recipient's needs. Using proper garbage disposal units is viable to be classified as eco-friendly waste management. Garbage disposers are suited for common kitchen waste and can shred large waste into smaller chunks that can decompose faster. In other words, waste disposal units facilitate the reduction of waste.

4. Obligations of the Supplier

The Supplier shall:

- Provide E-Waste materials that meet the agreed specifications and standards.
- Ensure timely delivery of the materials in accordance with the agreed schedule.
- Adhere to all applicable local, state, and federal regulations concerning the collection, handling, and disposal of E-Waste.
- Provide all necessary documentation related to the materials, including [certificates, recycling reports, or other required paperwork].

5. Obligations of the Recipient

The Recipient shall:

- Utilize the E-Waste materials solely for the purpose specified in this MoU.
- Ensure proper handling, recycling, or disposal of any hazardous materials in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.
- Inform the Supplier promptly if the materials do not meet the agreed specifications.

6. Duration

This MoU will be effective from the date of execution and remain in effect for five years, unless terminated earlier by either party with one month notice in writing.

7. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality regarding any proprietary or sensitive information exchanged during the course of this agreement. The confidentiality obligations will survive the termination of this MoU.

8. Termination

Either party may terminate this MoU with [number of days] written notice in the event of:

- A material breach of the terms by the other party.
- Failure to comply with applicable laws and regulations regarding E-Waste handling.
- Mutual agreement of both parties.

9. Dispute Resolution

In the event of any dispute arising under this MoU, the parties will first attempt to resolve the dispute through good faith negotiation. If unresolved, the dispute will be submitted to mediation or arbitration in accordance with [specify applicable laws or dispute resolution procedures].

10. Liability and Indemnity

Each party shall indemnify and hold harmless the other party against any claims, damages, or liabilities arising from the improper handling, transportation, or disposal of E-Waste materials supplied under this MoU.

11. Governing Law

This MoU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of [state/country].

12. Amendments

Any amendments to this MoU shall be made in writing and signed by both parties.



13. Miscellaneous

- This MoU does not create a partnership, joint venture, or employment relationship between the parties.
- Both parties acknowledge that this MoU does not create any binding legal obligations, except for confidentiality and dispute resolution provisions.
- The MoU may be executed in counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original.
