Brief Report

A financial study was conducted on 23/01/2024. 100 families of Take Ghoti village under Economics department of Karmaveer Punjababa Govardhan Arts, Commerce and Science College, Igatpuri. The students of the department of Economics collected the information by conducting a preliminary survey based on the questionnaire. The following conclusions were drawn from this information.

- 1) A survey of a total of one hundred families in Take Ghoti village shows that 85% of household heads are in the age group of 18 to 30, 17% in the age group of 31 to 42, 32% in the age group of 43 to 55, and 32% in the age group of 56 to 55. The percentage of heads of households in the age group of 100 was found to be 43%. From this it can be seen that the proportion of heads in the age group of 56 to 100 in Take Ghoti village is more than 50%.
- 2) After a survey of a total of one hundred households in Take Ghoti village it is found that the percentage of female heads is only 1% while the percentage of male heads is 11%, indicating a male dominated culture in this village.
- 3) A survey of a total of one hundred families in Take Ghoti village shows that only 18% of those with higher education are college graduates while 82% of families who do not have higher education or college degrees show that the proportion of higher education in the said Take Ghoti village is minimal.
- 4) A survey of a total of one hundred families in the National Service Scheme labor camp in Take Ghoti village shows that out of 100 families, the percentage of families with yellow ration cards is 37%, while the percentage of families with saffron ration cards is 44% and the percentage of families with white ration cards is 19%. Is From this it is clear that more than 50% of the population of the village is in desperate economic condition.
- 5) A survey of a total of hundred families in Take-Ghoti village shows that the percentage of families having less than one acre of land is 52%. The percentage of households having more than one acre of land is 17%, while the percentage of non-farming households is 13%.



Title- Economic study of a family in a tribal area of Igatpuri taluka-with reference to Take-Ghoti village

Objectives:

- 1. To conduct a comprehensive economic study of tribal families in Igatpuri taluka.
- 2. To identify the economic challenges faced by tribal families and propose sustainable solutions.
- 3. To empower tribal families through economic education and skill development.

Context: The department recognized the need to study the economic conditions of tribal families in Igatpuri taluka, who face significant challenges in terms of poverty, unemployment, and limited access to education and healthcare.

The Practice:

- 1. Conducting a Comprehensive Survey: A team of researchers conducted a detailed survey of 100 tribal families in Igatpuri taluka, collecting data on their economic activities, income, expenditure, and challenges.
